Applications for participation shall be sent until April 30, 2011,

including the title of the report, author's full name, institution, year, academic degree; scientific adviser's full name, position, academic or scientific degree.

The abstracts of the reports will be published, if sent by e-mail until January 31, 2011.

The abstracts shall be written on A4 page (not more than 1 page), M8 Word, Times New Roman, font size 14 pt, single spacing. The title of the report — centered, capitalized, bold. Author's full name (bold), institution, year, academic degree; scientific adviser's full name (bold), position, academic or scientific degree — centered. The body text shall be regular, justified, no indentations, margins: left 2.5 cm, right 2.5 cm, top 2.2 cm, bottom 1.2 cm. References (bold) shall be aligned left, numbered, ordered alphabetically, stating the author, title, publisher, year of publishing, number of pages for printed sources or title, link and dates of viewing for web sources, e.g.:
